A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, NC GreenPower is a landmark initiative approved by the North Carolina Utilities Commission, and is the first statewide green energy program in the nation administered independently by a nonprofit organization and supported by all of the state's utilities; and

WHEREAS, NC GreenPower improves North Carolina's environment through voluntary consumer contributions toward renewable energy; and

WHEREAS, NC GreenPower provides citizens and businesses an easy and affordable way to impact the future of our state by improving our quality of life and creating a more stable energy supply; and

WHEREAS, NC GreenPower provides a model for collaboration between environmental advocates and the business sector in its cooperation with electric utilities across the state, and gives businesses, industry and government a way to exercise their corporate social responsibility; and

WHEREAS, NC GreenPower provides information from a global perspective about energy and shows citizens how renewable energy can benefit the environment and economy of North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, NC GreenPower's renewable energy is made in North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, NC GreenPower encourages cleaner energy solutions so that we can provide a healthier environment for our children while still powering homes and businesses across the state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MICHAEL F. EASLEY, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim October 1, 2004, as "RENEWABLE ENERGY DAY" in North Carolina. I urge our citizens to renew their commitment to environmental stewardship, sustaining God's gift of environmental natural bounty and committing to a clean and green future.
