Homeowners:

- Keep access doors closed, especially during warm weather
- Do not store solvents, gasoline or other hazardous materials in the crawlspace
- Inspect the crawlspace regularly for water damage and/or leaks
- Drain or pump any water, especially flooding, out of the crawlspace

Contractors:

- Remove shoes before entering
- Do not leave the reinforced path
- Do not damage or remove any systems in the crawlspace
- Inspect the crawlspace for water damage and/or leaks

Your Closed Crawlspace:

Your closed crawlspace is designed to be more durable and energy-efficient than traditional crawlspaces. Since the crawlspace is not vented to the outdoors, it reduces the humidity levels and the potential for mold in your crawlspace. Research also shows that your crawlspace may save up to 15% on your annual energy usage compared to vented crawlspaces.
